Month	Fund	Details
June	Membership Dues (Mandatory for each member)	Annual dues of \$35/member are due on June 1 st of the 2020-2021 Fiscal Year. (\$1.50 of each members dues is donated to the Hoodless Homestead; \$3.50 of each member's dues is sent to FWIC)
July		
August	Pennies For Friendship	Usually a collection is taken at AGM or Provincial Convention. Donations are also accepted year-round from Branches and Districts.
September		
October	Peace Garden Fund	Donations of any amount are accepted by FWIC for the upkeep of the International Peace Gardens, located on the border of North Dakota and Manitoba.
November	Every Stamp Counts Challenge	Branches and Districts are encouraged to accept the challenge and donate new stamps to the WINS office.

January	District Director Fund	Each Branch donates \$20 to help cover the expenses of District Directors attending Provincial Board Meetings. (Branches can choose to include their District Director Fund donation with their membership dues)
February	Scholarship Fund	Funds help to build the scholarship fund and assist students with secondary education expenses.

April	ACWW Donations	April is ACWW Month. Branches and Districts are encouraged to support the various ACWW projects*.
