- 3. Letter of recommendation from head of school last attended.
- 4. Letter of recommendation from sponsoring Women's Institute Branch, <u>signed by two</u>

  <u>Branch Executive Members, including character reference, financial need and community involvement.</u>
- 5. Letter from applicant telling what career he/she has chosen and reasons why.
- 6. Transcript of final marks from Grade 11, as well as most recent from Grade 12.
- 7. Copy of acceptance letter from institution.

Please note: Any items included in your application package not listed above (e.g. resume, newspaper articles, awards/certificates, etc.) will be discarded and not considered for evaluation purposes.

## Women's Institutes of Nova Scotia Family Scholarship 2024 Regulations

- 1. One W.I.N.S. Family Scholarship of \$700 is offered annually to W.I.N.S. members, their husbands, children, grandchildren, nieces, nephews, sisters-in-law, brothers-in-law and wards.
- 2. The purpose of the scholarship is to provide assistance to a graduating high school student who wishes to obtain training at a recognized technical institute, school of nursing, college or university in Canada.
- 3. The scholarship will be available as follows: \$700 to be paid to the institution, in the name of the student, at the beginning of the second term of the first year upon receipt of a letter from the Registrar of the institution indicating the student is enrolled for that term. The student is responsible for obtaining this letter from the registrar.
- 4. This scholarship will be awarded to a student whose permanent residence is in Nova Scotia.
- 5. Applicants must include notice of acceptance by the technical institute, school of nursing, college or university with application.
- 6. Applicants are asked to mail or deliver all seven (7) items as stated on the reverse of this form to <a href="Women's Institutes of Nova Scotia">Women's Institutes of Nova Scotia</a>, 208-90 Research Drive, Bible Hill, NS, B6L 2R2.
  - Late or incomplete application packages will not be considered. Additional items, other than those listed on front, will be discarded before evaluation as well.
- 7. In addition to scholastic standing, applicants will also be judged on evidence of good character, leadership skills, participation in extracurricular and community activities, and financial need.
- 8. Winners of the scholarship shall be chosen by a committee of the Women's Institutes of Nova Scotia.
- 9. No student will be awarded more than one Women's Institutes of Nova Scotia scholarship.

Presentation of the award is to be made at the high school graduation ceremony. If possible, this presentation will be done by a local Women's Institute member.
